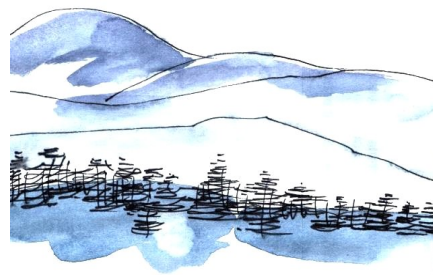

President's Report

As you may know, I have experienced a health crisis that may affect my ability to serve the rest of this year. For this reason, the 2026 candidate for Board President had agreed to join the Board this year as Vice President.

Kathy Yeager-Byllesby was elected the 2025 Vice President at the August 28, 2025 General Membership Meeting and was installed by telephone at that meeting. Mrs. Yeager-Byllesby had served as Venue Assistant in 2018, Vice President in 2019 and President of the Board in 2020, the year the Club ceased operations in March until May of 2021 due to Covid. She served as Parliamentarian briefly in 2021, so she has not exceeded the limitation for further service outlined in the Club's Bylaws.

Activities Director Paula Yelle has stepped up as Acting President in my recent absence and will relinquish that responsibility when Mrs. Yeager-Byllesby returns from her trip out of state. The next time you see Ms. Yelle, please thank her for accepting this additional responsibility and doing a great job in keeping our Club running!

A major operational change is in progress this year: a transition from Wild Apricot to GlueUp, a similar Association Management System (AMS). GlueUp has the same functionality as Wild Apricot for automating memberships and luncheon, reservations, among other features, only with more current and familiar software features. Membership Assistant Mary O'Hair is leading the transition team and working with GlueUp to complete the transition within the next couple of months.

The nominating Committee is still searching for a Vice President and Information Systems Director to serve on the 2026 Board and continues to look for individuals to fill Assistant positions as well. If you have thought about serving on the Board, becoming an Assistant is a great way to meet other Board members and get some experience. The 2026 Slate of Directors will be approved by Board and announced to the membership with the goal of electing them at the November Luncheon and General Meeting.

Lastly, but not least, have you purchased your tickets for the October 25th Big Event? The Beatles Flashed is coming to Newcomers! Some of you may have caught their shows around town and, from everything I have heard, they put on a spectacular performance, we already have 110 registrations and will have to close registration after 168 members make the commitment. 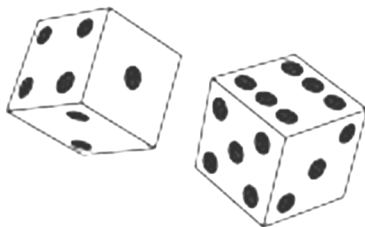

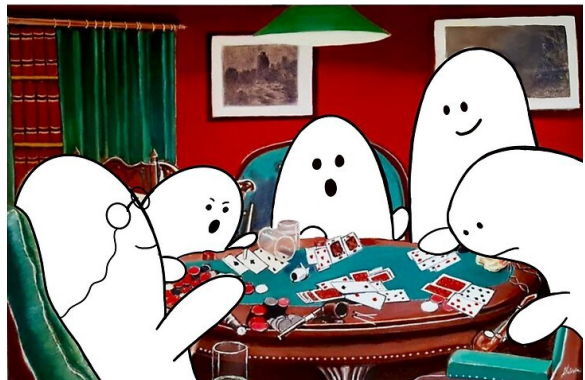
